

Local Control & Accountability Plan (LCAP) Fall 2017 Parent & Student Survey Results Options for Youth San Juan

Focus Groups were held at the school centers between the months of September and November of 2017. These meetings were presented in order to provide parents and students with more information about LCAP and our school-wide goals for the 2017-2018 school year. Additionally, parents and students were invited to provide feedback and engage in discussion around improving our programs and supports for students.

1 Meeting was held throughout the charter with parents, students, and family members in attendance.

An **online survey** was administered at the conclusion of each Focus Group Meeting as well as distributed to parents in a variety of ways throughout the Focus Group period. Through these surveys parents were again invited to provide feedback around improving our programs and supports for students, particularly focusing on school climate and connectedness to OFY San Juan. Students were surveyed through the **online assessment** platform during their scheduled appointment times.

Parent Survey Results

200 parents/guardians participated in the survey

91%

of parents/guardians are satisfied or completely satisfied with their experience at OFY San Juan.

99%

of parents/guardians feel they are somewhat likely or very likely to refer a friend or family member to OFY San Juan.

92%

of parents agree or strongly agree that their student is safe at OFY San Juan.

94%

of parents/guardians feel their student is somewhat likely or very likely to stay enrolled at OFY San Juan for the next 12 months or until graduation.

69%

of parents agree or strongly agree that OFY San Juan has enough programs that develop students' social emotional skills.

Student Survey Results

795 students participated in the survey

86%

of students strongly agree or somewhat agree OFY San Juan's facilities are in good repair.

71%

of students strongly agree or somewhat agree OFY San Juan encourages parents to be involved in the school and in their child's education.

88%

of students strongly agree or somewhat agree OFY San Juan ensures that students have access to instructional materials, including technology.

81%

of students are satisfied or completely satisfied with their experience at OFY San Juan.

84%

of students strongly agree or somewhat agree OFY San Juan provides support that is specific to students individual needs.

83%

of students strongly agree or somewhat agree they feel safe and connected to OFY San Juan.
