Options for Youth Virtual Program

Focus Groups were held virutally thorugh the months of September and November of 2017. These meetings were presented in order to provide parents and students with more information about LCAP and our school-wide goals for the 2017-2018 school year. Additionally, parents and students were invited to provide feedback and engage in discussion around improving our programs and supports for students.

1 Meetings was held throughout the charter with 25 parents, students, and family members joined the virutal meeting.

An online survey was administered at the conclusion of each Focus Group Meeting as well as distributed to parents and students in a variety of ways throughout the Focus Group period. Through these surveys parents and students were again invited to provide feedback around improving our programs and supports particularly focusing on school climate and connectedness to the OFY Virtual Program.
