Since August 2018, OFY-A has been working on its Conflict of Interest Code to ensure it reflects the appropriate disclosure categories and designates the appropriate OFY-A officials, employees, and consultants for filing Form 700s. This revised Code updates the list of designated employees to add a new position, and moves positions that are not OFY-A employees to "Consultants." Also, this revised Code reflects disclosure categories common to other charter schools in Los Angeles County. Last, this revised Code follows the Code-approval process set out by the FPPC, acknowledging that the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, who is OFY-A's code-reviewing body pursuant to the Political Reform Act, is currently declining to serve as a code-reviewing body for charter schools like OFY-A that are authorized by a single authorizer.
